Our speakers will be David and Libby Doub.  
David and Libby grew up in Tennessee and  
graduated college from Tennessee Tech.  
David was a retail executive with several  
department stores and they have lived  
throughout the southeast. In 2008 they  
settled in Franklin County.

In January 2010 David was diagnosed  
with Acute Myeloid Leukemia (AML) and  
immediately started 77 days of treatment  
at Vanderbilt Hospital on his birthday.  
In March David's youngest brother was the  
donor for his stem cell transplant. After  
another 100 days at Vanderbilt Village  
Apartments, they returned home.
