

## **Preparing for the Walk-A-Thon**



The annual Walk-A-Thon is coming soon!! The date for this year's Walk is September 9th.

Plans are underway to include activities such as a children's area, silent auction, tent judging, quilt drawing, live music, food concessions and MORE.

The Multi-County Cancer Support Network has an annual budget of approximately \$137,000.00. Funds are distributed to cancer patients and their families at an average of \$8,000.00 plus per month. Except for one paid office manager who works three days a week and an office assistant who works one day a week, the organization is managed by an all volunteer force. The Walk -A-Thon provides approximately 60% of the funds required for the annual budget. Additional funds are provided by other fundraisers throughout the year. donations and memorials.

Your support for the Walk-A-Thon will be greatly appreciated.

A little history about MCCSN — In January of 1992, approximately 20 people gathered at a local church to discuss the possibility of forming a cancer support group where cancer patients, survivors, and their family members could find support from other people that understood what they were going through. It was at this meeting they realized they had stumbled upon a real need. Cancer often means the loss of a pay check for a period of several weeks or months and while the income is not there the bills continue to come in. Many people, especially the young and also the elderly are not able to deal with the extra financial strain. It was decided to officially form a non-profit support group under the name Multi-County Cancer Support Network a long name that is so perfect for what this organization is about. The mission is simple to provide emotional, educational and financial support to cancer patients, survivors, their families and friends. We try to relieve the everyday crises of families touched by cancer in an eight county area which is Franklin, Moore, Lincoln, Grundy, Marion, Warren, Bedford and Coffee. The office is located at 110 East Lauderdale Street in Tullahoma. The office hours are Tuesday, Thursday and Friday from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM and closed for lunch between 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 a.m.. Our organization is governed by a board consisting of a president, vice-president, treasurer. secretary and 12 directors which meet monthly to review, approve and disburse funds to assist cancer patients who are currently undergoing treatments or have been placed under hospice care.

## **Introducing Director Kayla Brown Walls**



My name is Kayla Brown Walls and I am a resident of Unionville, Tennessee, in Bedford County. I am 26 years old and a 2008 graduate of Community High School. In 2012, I graduated from Middle Tennessee State University with a Bachelor's degree in Agribusiness, a minor in secondary education, and a concentration in agriculture education. I have been employed as a teller with Peoples Bank of Middle Tennessee in Shelbyville since August 2012. My husband and I now live right down the road from the family farm where I grew up. We are active members of Maxwell Chapel Methodist Church, where I have attended all my life, have always had an interest in and a passion for agriculture and have a strong desire to one day teach high school agriculture. This passion for agriculture comes from the influence of the full-time farmers in my life, my maternal grandfather and my dad. I feel that too many of today's youth are growing up with no connection to farming or agriculture and have no real understanding of the importance or significance that agriculture plays in all our lives.

In January 2005, my dad was diagnosed with a very aggressive type of kidney cancer. He underwent surgery and had the kidney removed, followed by chemotherapy, but sadly lost his battle with this horrible disease, passing away in November 2005, at the age of 52. I was only 16 years old and a sophomore in high school.

A few years later, in 2012, my husband lost his father to throat cancer. He, too, was only 52 years old. I have seen first-hand how terrible cancer is and what it does to a person and to their families. I have just begun serving on the MCCSN Board of Directors in 2016. I feel that I can be an asset to the MCCSN organization because I am able to relate to the family members of cancer patients and show compassion to them.
